The COAR school provides a kindergarten to grade twelve school education to about 800 children from Zaragoza and neighboring villages. State approved vocational training is offered to high school students. The COAR Clinic, a quality medical clinic in an area with little other access to health care, serves the health and dental needs of up to 25-50 patients (adults and children) weekly. The Archdiocese of San Salvador through its Caritas ministries administers COAR Children's Village. The COAR Peace Mission in Cleveland, OH is the support and development office for the Children's Village in El Salvador. COAR was founded in August 1980 by Rev. Ken Myers, a priest of the Cleveland Diocese.
